P.R.E.P. Specialist: Works 4 hours per day, Monday - Friday, 8:30 AM – 12:30 PM - \$8.00 per hour - 7 weeks of employment
() **P.R.E.P. Specialists** work at the Town's preschool recreational education program – a preschool program for children ages 3-5. **Applicant should be enrolled in elementary/secondary education courses or a related field.** This program is held on the third floor at the Rotterdam Senior Citizen Center.

R.A.P. Specialist: Works 4 hours per day, Monday - Friday, 8:30 AM – 12:30 PM - \$8.00 per hour - 7 weeks of employment
() **R.A.P. Specialists** work at the town's recreational activity program, a structured program for children ages 6-8. **Applicant should be enrolled in elementary/secondary education courses or a related field.** This program is held at the Pinewood Elementary School.

Summer Sports Camp Counselor: Works 6 hours per day, Monday - Friday, 8:30 AM – 3:30 PM - \$8.00 per hour - 7 weeks of employment.
() **Camp Counselors** work at the town's summer sports camp for children ages 9-13. **Applicants should be enrolled in elementary/secondary education courses or a related field.**

To apply for a position as a P.R.E.P., R.A.P. or Summer Sports Camp Counselor:

1. You must have graduated from high school.
2. You are planning to attend or are currently attending college.

If you have worked in the Summer Recreation Parks Programs for **three (3) summers**, you may not be re-hired. Our goal is to provide college students the opportunity to work a summer position in their field of interest. *Application must be filled out completely to be considered.
