



June Bus Trips

June 4th and 6th: Saratoga Racino and/or Shopping in downtown Saratoga.

Name your pleasure and our driver, Mark will happily take you to your destination! Will it be Racino to try your luck, or do you prefer to stroll the streets in the heart of downtown Saratoga and visit the beautiful unique shops and eateries. The bus departs at 10:00 AM.

June 11th and 12th Historic Cherry Hill, Albany NY. Lunch to follow at Capital City Diner.

Historic Cherry Hill tells a story of America through the lives and experiences of five generations of an Albany, New York, family. One of Albany's most recognizable landmarks, Cherry Hill was built in 1787 for Philip and Maria Van Rensselaer and continuously lived in until 1963 by extended family, enslaved people, descendants and servants- who left artifacts, documents and stories behind. Rare among this country's house museums, Cherry Hill's extensive and intact collection includes more than 70,000 items-decorative arts and furnishings, books, diaries, documents, clothing, bedding, photographs, and other objects reflecting daily life-all related to the family that lived here. Admission is \$4.00. This tour involves stairs to upper floors. The bus departs at 10:00

June 18th: Proctor's Noontime Organ Concerts. Malcolm Kogut Lunch to follow at Bellevue Cafe.

Malcolm writes both popular and sacred music and won the National Association of Pastoral Musicians Musician of the year award in 1999. He has two CD's of original works to his credit along with many published piano and choral books. Malcolm played in the pit for many Broadway touring shows. The concert is free. The bus departs at 11:30 a.m.

June 27th: Olana House Tour, Olana Historical Site, Hudson NY. Lunch to follow at 225 Bar and Grill, Hudson.

Olana State Historical Site is a historic house museum and landscape in Greenport, New York, near the city of Hudson. The estate was home to Frederic-Edwin Church, one of the major figures in the Hudson River School of Landscape painting. This 45-minute guided tour provides an introduction to Frederic Church's home at Olana. Approach and enter the Historic House as guest of the Church family, experiencing sweeping views of the Hudson Valley and Catskill Mountains. Explore the art-filled, lavishly decorated public rooms of the first floor, including Church's painting studio, and learn about the work and life of America's preeminent landscape artist. Tickets must be purchased in advance, please pay at the Senior Center when you register for this bus trip. The tour is \$20.00. The tour is at 11:30. The bus departs at 9:30
