Thursday, September 5: Bennington Museum. Lunch to follow at Mt. Anthony Country Club.

Bennington Museum presents and explores the rich culture of southern Vermont, eastern New York State, northwestern Massachusetts, and southern New Hampshire in all its forms, from the 18th century to the present. Bennington Museum holds the largest collection of art and historical artifacts in southern Vermont, reflecting a rich culture of innovation that has characterized the region for two and a half centuries. The diverse collections range from letters written by George Washington to contemporary art and the largest collection of American folk artist, Grandma Moses. On the way home, you will stop at the Potter Hill Barn to do a little shopping. Admission to the Museum is \$12.00. The Bus will depart at 9:00.
